THE GUSTAV V.R. BORN VAS INTERNATIONAL HONORARY AWARD

MISSION

To foster research in vascular disorders through recognition of research excellence in the fields of public health, vascular medicine, vascular biology, haemostasis, atherosclerosis, thrombosis and platelet function.

Prof. Gustav V.R. Born (Gus for his friends) has been a VAS member since 1998, chairman of the VAS Ethics and Guarantors Committees and teacher in several Master and Postgraduates Courses.

THE AWARD

The VAS awards every other year a prize to honour personalities worldwide who have distinguished themselves in medical research on public health, vascular medicine, vascular biology, haemostasis, atherosclerosis, thrombosis and platelet pathophysiology.

As a rule, the prize is usually awarded on the occasion of the annual VAS Academic meeting (European Angiology Days –end November each year) to one scientist.

Awardees receive a honorary plaque and become member of the VAS International Academy.

NOMINATIONS

Nominations should be submitted by May 31st each year to the VAS G.V.R. BORN International Award committee and should contain the following information:

- Name, title and institution of the nominee
- A CV and bibliography of the nominee
- Nominator contact information
- Description of the nominee's research and its relevance for the award's mission and the top five references related to the research
- Two letters in support of the nomination

SELECTION

Nominations will be screened by a restricted scientific advisory board and the best three will be selected for evaluation by the whole scientific board of the G.V.R. BORN INTERNATIONAL AWARDS.

Nominators and nominees will be notified of the award by the end of September.

The decision on the award winner is taken by the whole scientific board by majority and it is irrevocable.
